Reading: Excerpt from Greater Perfection, page 47 – 48

If only we could make ourselves realize that the will of God orders and directs every moment of our lives, we should become saints before we knew it. For sanctity does not consist in visions and revelations, but in the perfect conformity of the human will with the Divine. This is not easy, for the liberty of our free will is our dearest possession. For this reason also it is the choicest gift that we can offer to Almighty God. And to bring that will into submission requires persistence and sacrifice – a constant, resolute effort in the monotony of daily tasks, and amid frequent failures; a daily struggle to conquer and subdue self. Only one thing in the world is strong enough to overcome love or self – I am speaking from a supernatural viewpoint always – and that is love of God. All grace has been given us in Christ Jesus, our Mediator with the Father, who yearns to pour out upon us the abundance of gifts He bought at the price of His precious Blood. But without cooperation He can do nothing, for there is one thing which even God will never take away from us, and which He, so to speak, respects, and that is our free will. We are sanctified in precisely the exact proportion in which we will attain sanctity, in which we will to submit to God's action in us.
